Discussion Topics Included:

- ***The Ascension Day Service***—The group discussed the Ascension Day service.
  - Feedback was received that the service was well done. Particular mention of the music was made, particularly the addition of the contemporary music provided by Denny Daugherty.

- **Book Study**—There will be a book study on Associate Conference Minister, Rev. Dr. Laurene Bowers' book, Designing Contemporary Congregations. The kick off for this book study will be through her message at the Leadership Banquet. We will be communicating with Laurene about having copies of her book available for purchase (and her signature!) at the Leadership Banquet. The book study would be (Tuesdays) March 6<sup>th</sup> and March 20<sup>th</sup> from 6 to 8 or 7 to 9. Because the book is short, either one session would be devoted to the entire session (allowing for two different opportunities to attend depending on schedule), or the first half of the book discussed on March 6<sup>th</sup> and the second half discussed on March 20<sup>th</sup>. There would be a discussion regarding how to translate her insights into our own congregations and also the York Association. Possible venue: Martin Library.
- **Clergy-Spouse/Significant Other Group**—Over the last two years (perhaps longer?), the Parish Life Committee has received feedback that there is a desire/need for a group of some kind for Clergy Spouses/Significant others. The Team is attempting to address this idea. Because it is unclear whether or not clergy spouse's actually want this group (or if it is simply clergy who want their spouses to have this group), we are having an "evening out", which will be both social and informational in nature. The event, which will take place on **Friday, October 14<sup>th</sup> from 7 to 9 PM at the Four Points Sheraton in York**, will feature an hour of appetizers and drinks (non-alcoholic). The second hour will be a breakout session. Mike Gibbs will work with the clergy to determine any ideas for parish life that they might have, and Elva Winter, a clergy spouse and licensed therapist will facilitate a discussion with the significant others to determine their need/interest in a group for them, and the nature of this group. After gathering this information, the Parish Life Team will seek to develop a program that meets the identified needs/desires of the group.
- **Leadership Banquet**—The Parish Life team continues with plans for the Leadership Banquet to take place on Sunday, February 12<sup>th</sup>. The speaker will be Rev. Dr. Laurene Bowers and will be on a theme to be identified by the team, mostly likely around the themes of congregational vitality.

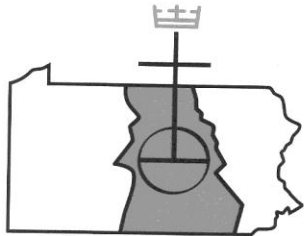

Dear Barbara,

We have an exciting opportunity for our pastors this winter. Peter Steinke, author of *Leadership in Anxious Times* and *A Door Set Open: Grounding Change in Mission and Hope*, as well as other books, will be the featured speaker for our Penn Central Conference Mid-Winter Convocation at the Hotel Hershey, January 24-26, 2012. Steinke will bring fresh perspectives for our clergy as they serve as leaders of our churches in challenging times.

***A Door Set Open: Leaders of Change and Hope*** will be the topic he addresses during the convocation. This is an excellent opportunity for leadership development that we would like all of our pastors to benefit from.


We are asking each Association to prayerfully consider helping to underwrite \$750 in scholarships – giving five scholarships of \$150 each to offer to five “new” pastors in the York Association. This would greatly enhance the pastoral development of the pastoral leaders in the York Association!

The convocation begins with worship and a presentation on Tuesday afternoon. Wednesday there are two more presentations, with the closing presentation and worship on Thursday morning.

Cost for the convocation ranges from \$380 per person (double occupancy; early registration) for those who take part in all the sessions, and this includes the room and meals. There is a fee of \$60 for those who only want to take advantage of the sessions on Wednesday and do not wish to be included in any meals. And there are other options for single occupancy, commuters, and meals on Wednesday only. A Convocation brochure has been included for you to review.

We are hopeful that the York Association will be able to make this important and valuable convocation available to many of its pastors and congregations!

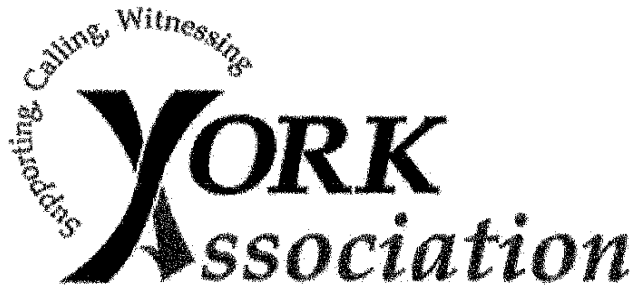

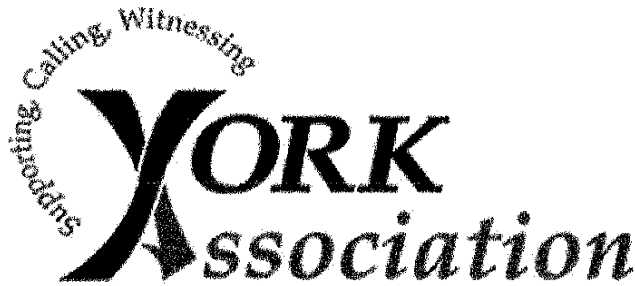
