Outreach Is Alive and Well at Zion UCC

Zion is partnering with the City of York to restore the historic Gardener's Shed, aka Penn- Coates Building/Penn Park, replacing the pavilions and creating a public picnic area in Penn Park. Additionally, Zion will again be sponsoring 'Tennis for Kids,' from June 13 through July 13 and Creative Arts 'Art in the Parks' from July 11 through July 15, both in Penn Park.
